GLOSSARY

- ANALGESIC** A drug which relieves or diminishes pain; anodyne.
- ANESTHETIC** An agent that deadens sensation.
- ANTIBIOTIC** An agent that destroys or arrests the growth of micro-organisms.
- ANTISPASMODIC** An agent that relieves spasms or cramps.
- ANTITUSSIVE** An agent that relieves coughing.
- HSV** Herpes simplex virus; produces the familiar cold sores in humans.
- IATROGENITIC** A disease developed as a direct result of the doctors treatment.
- OXYTOCIC** An agent that stimulates contraction of the uterine muscle and so facilitates or speeds up childbirth.
- YOGAMETRICS** the synthesis of yoga and isometrics. One minute of yogametrics is equal to fifteen minutes of isometrics; fifteen minutes of isometrics is equal to one hour of weight-lifting.
